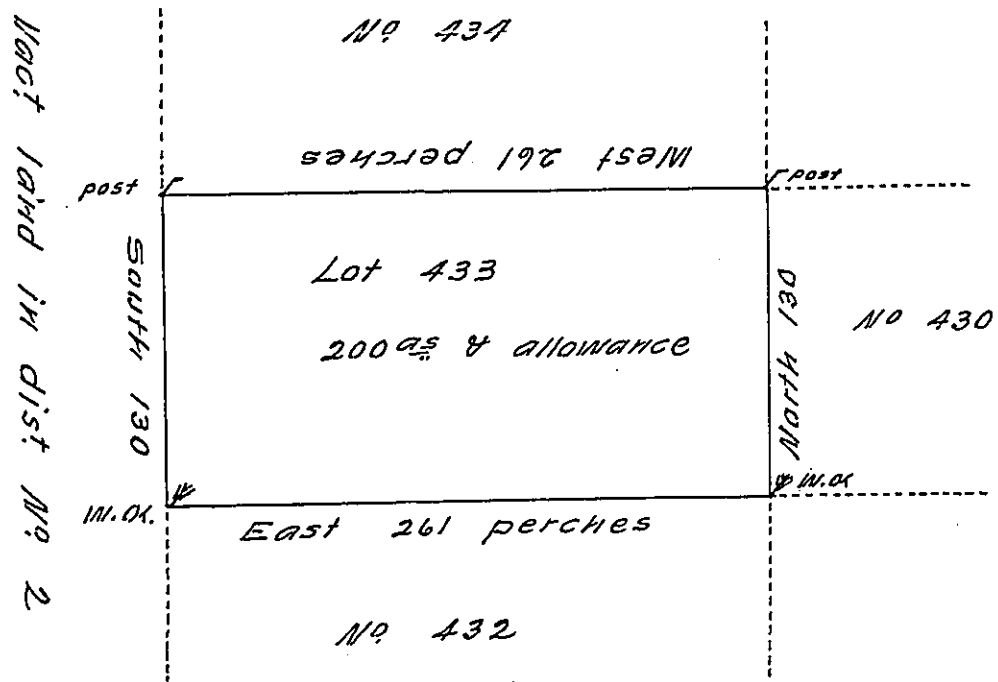

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785 entitled an Act for directing the mode of distributing the donation lands promised the troops by this Commonwealth and by order of the Surveyor General with approbation of the Honourable Executive Council I have surveyed the 20<sup>th</sup> day of December 1785 the above described tract of two hundred acres of land and allowance of six  $\frac{7}{8}$  cent. for roads &c No 433 situate in district No. 2 on the west side of Allegheny river in Westmoreland County.
