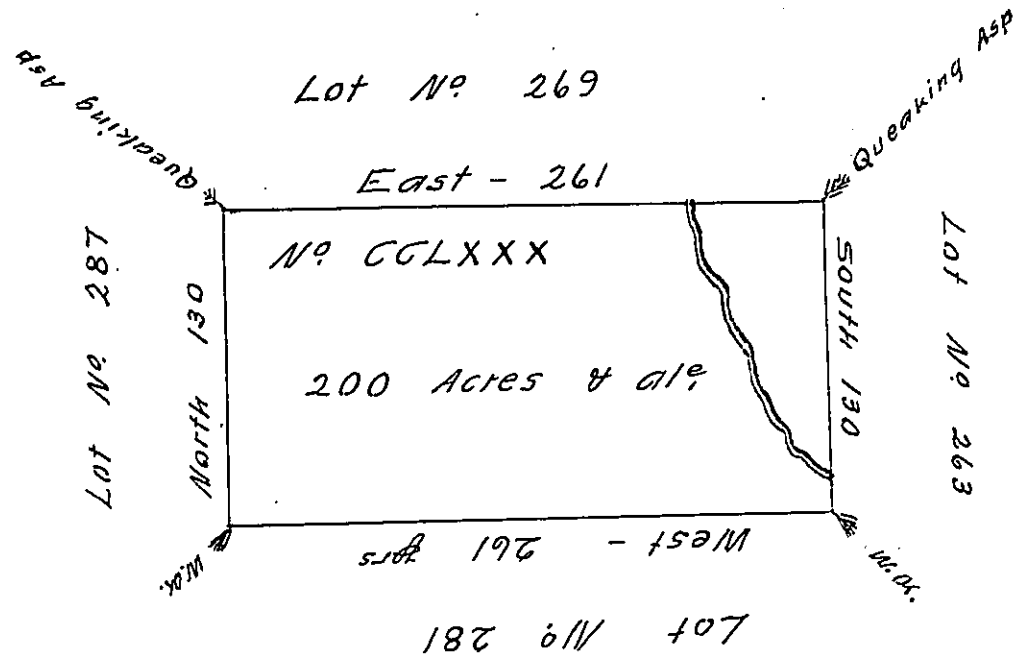

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785 entitled an Act for directing the mode of distributing the donation lands promised the troops of the commonwealth & by order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Honourable the Executive Council. I have surveyed on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of October 1785 the above described tract of two hundred acres of land & the allowance of six per cent for roads No CCLXXX situate in district No 2 on the west side of ALEGANY river in West-Mareland County
