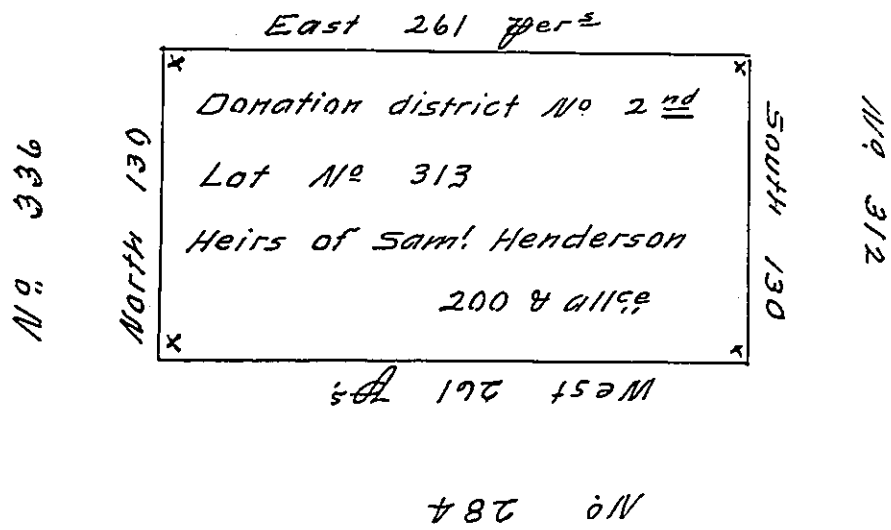

In pursuance of an Act of the General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785 entitled an Act for directing the mode of distributing the donation lands promised the troops of this Commonwealth and by order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Honbl<sup>e</sup> Executive Council, there was surveyed the above described tract of land containing two hundred acres with the usual allowance of six <sup>per</sup> cents for roads, situate in district No 2 now in Butler County <sup>Lot</sup> No 313.

Taken from the General Draft remaining in the Surveyor General's office the 8<sup>th</sup> day of January 1803 on which day the above No was drawn in favor of the heirs of Samuel Henderson decd. Saml Cochran S.B.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this Thirtieth day of April 1908
