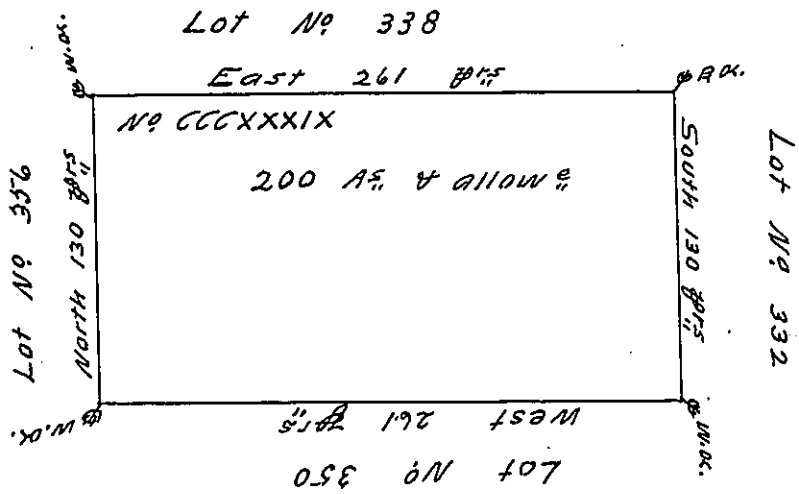

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785 entitled an Act for directing the mode of distributing the donation lands promised the troops of this Commonwealth & by order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of — honourable the Executive Council. I have surveyed on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of November 1785 the above described tract of two hundred acres of land & the allowance of six p<sup>t</sup>s cent for roads No CCCXXXIX situate in district No 2 on the west side of Allegany river in Westmoreland County
