


LOT N° 913



In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly  
of the State of Pennsylvania passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February  
1785 entitled an Act for directing the Mode of distributing  
the Donation Lands promised the Troops of this Commonwealth  
and by Order of the Surveyor General, with the Approbation  
of the Hon<sup>r</sup> the Executive Council, I have surveyed on the 4<sup>th</sup>  
day of October 1785, the above Described Tract of Land Con-  
taining three Hundred Acres & Allowance of Six P<sup>r</sup> Cent. for  
Roads &c N° XLV. situate in District N° 5 on the West side of  
the Allegany River in the County of Westmoreland.
