


Donation-Land, in District No. 6.

LOT, NO. MCXXXVII



IN PURSUANCE OF AN ACT OF GENERAL ASSEMBLY
of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty-fourth Day
of February 1785, intitled, 'An Act for directing the Mode of
distributing the Donation-Lands promised to the Troops by this
'Commonwealth,' and by Order of the Surveyor-General, with the
Approbation of the Honourable the Executive-Council, I have
surveyed, on the ninth Day of November 1785, the above de-
scribed Tract of Two hundred Acres of Land, and Allowance
of Six per Cent for Roads, &c. No. 1137, situate in District No. 6,
on the West Side of the Allegheny River, in the County of Westmoreland.
