


FORM NO 1.

Donation-Land, in District N^o 6Lot, N^o MCVII

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly
of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty-fourth Day
of February 1785, intitled, 'An Act for directing the Mode of dis-
tributing the Donation-Lands promised to the Troops by this Com-
monwealth; and by Order of the Surveyor-General, with the Ap-
probation of the Honourable the Executive-Council, I have sur-
veyed, on the fifth Day of November 1785, the above described
Tract of TWO hundred Acres of Land, and Allowance of six per
Cent for Roads, &c. No. 1107 situate in District No. 6, on the West
Side of the Allegheny River, in the County of Westmoreland.
