


Donation Land in District No 6

Lot No MCKXVII



In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly
of the state of Pennsylvania passed the 24th Day of February
1785 entitled "an Act for directing the mode of distributing the
donation Lands promised the Troops of this Commonwealth"
and by order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of
the Hon^{ble} the Executive Council, I have surveyed on the 13th
Day of November 1785 the above described Tract of TWO
Hundred Acres of Land & Allowance of six Pct for roads &c No
1127 situate in District No 6 on the West side of Allegheny
River in the County of Westmoreland
