

IN PURSUANCE OF AN ACT OF GENERAL ASSEMBLY
OF THE STATE OF PENNSYLVANIA, PASSED THE TWENTY-FOURTH DAY
OF FEBRUARY 1785, INTITLED, 'AN ACT FOR DIRECTING THE MODE OF
DISTRIBUTING THE DONATION-LANDS PROMISED TO THE TROOPS BY THIS
'COMMONWEALTH', AND BY ORDER OF THE SURVEYOR-GENERAL, WITH THE
APPROBATION OF THE HONOURABLE THE EXECUTIVE-COUNCIL, I HAVE SUR-
VEYED, ON THE TWENTY-FOURTH DAY OF NOVEMBER 1785, THE ABOVE
DESCRIBED TRACT OF TWO HUNDRED ACRES OF LAND, AND ALLOWANCE OF
SIX PER CENT FOR ROADS, &c. NO. 1229 SITUATE IN DISTRICT NO. 6, ON
THE WEST SIDE OF THE ALLEGHENY RIVER, IN THE COUNTY OF WESTMORELAND.
