


Donation-Land, in District No. 6

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly
of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty-fourth Day
of February 1785, intitled, 'An Act for directing the Mode of
distributing the Donation-Lands promised to the Troops by this
'Commonwealth,' and by order of the Surveyor-General, with the
Approbation of the Honourable the Executive-Council, I have
surveyed, on the Thirtieth Day of November 1785, the above de-
scribed Tract of TWO hundred Acres of Land, and Allowance of
Six per Cent for Roads, &c. No. 1288 situate in District No. 6, on
the West side of the Allegheny River, in the County of Westmore-
land.
