

In pursuance of an act of General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785. the above Intitled an act for Directing the mode of Distributing the Donation Lands Promised to the Troops of this Commonwealth & by Order of the Surveyor Gen<sup>r</sup>l with the Approbation of the Hon<sup>r</sup> the Executive Council I have surveyed on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of Aug<sup>t</sup> 1785. the above Described tract of two Hundred As. & Allow. of 6 PCent for Roads &c No MCCCCXX situate in Dist N° 7 on the West side of the Alleg<sup>y</sup> River in the County of Westmorland.
