

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly  
of the State of Penn<sup>g</sup>: passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of Feb<sup>r</sup>: 1785, entitled  
"an Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation Lands  
promised the Troops of this Commonwealth," and by order of the Sur-  
veyor General, with the approbation of the Hon<sup>t</sup> the Executive  
Council, I have Survey'd on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of September 1785 the above  
described Tract of two hundred Acres of Land & allowance of six  
Perch for Roads &c. N<sup>o</sup> DCCCLII. situate in District N<sup>o</sup> 4 on the West  
side of the Allegany river in the County of Westmoreland.
