

of the state of Pennsylvania passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February  
1785 Intituled an act for Directing the mode of Distributing the Dona-  
tion Lands Promised to the troops of this Commonwealth & by Order  
of the Surveyor General with the Approbation of the Hon<sup>t</sup> the  
Executive Council I have Surveyed On the 6<sup>th</sup> day of Aug<sup>t</sup> 1785 the  
Above Described tract of two Hundred Acres & Allow of 6 P Cent  
for roads &c No MCCCXCI situate in Dist N° 7 on the West side of  
the Allegeny River in the County of Westmorland.
