

In Pursuance of an act of Gen<sup>t</sup> Assembly of  
the state of Pennsylvania passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785, In-  
titled an act for Directing the mode of Distributing the Donation  
Lands promised to the troops of this Commonwealth & by order  
of the Surveyor Gen<sup>t</sup> with the approbation of the Hon<sup>t</sup> the  
Executive Council I have surveyed on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of Sep<sup>r</sup> 1785.  
the Above Described tract of two Hund<sup>d</sup> Acres & Allow<sup>s</sup> of 6 P Cent  
for roads &c No MDXVI situate in Dis N<sup>o</sup> 7 on the west side of the  
Allegh<sup>y</sup> River in the County of Westmorlan<sup>d</sup>.
