


Lot N 452



In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of  
 the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty fourth Day of February,  
 one thousand seven hundred and eighty five, entitled an Act "for di-  
 recting the Mode of distributing the Donation Lands, promised to the Troops  
 by this Commonwealth," and by Order of the Surveyor General, with the  
 Approbation of the Honorable the Executive Council, I have surveyed on  
 the 25<sup>th</sup> Day of September one thousand seven hundred and eighty five,  
 the above described Tract of Two hundred Acres of Land, and Allowance  
 for Roads, &c No. 453 situate in District No. III, on the West Side of the  
 Alligany River, in the County of Westmoreland.
