


## Donation - Land, in District No. 6.

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of  
the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty-fourth Day of February  
1785, intitled, 'An Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Do-  
nation-Lands promised to the Troops by this Commonwealth; and by  
Order of the Surveyor-General, with the approbation of the Honourable  
the Executive Council, I have surveyed, on the Eleventh Day of Nov-  
ember 1785, the above described Tract of Two hundred Acres of Land,  
and Allowance of six per cent for Roads, &c. No. 1142 situate in  
District No. 6, on the West Side of the Allegheny River, in the County  
of Westmoreland.
