


Lot N 540



In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly
of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty-fourth Day of February,
one thousand seven hundred and eighty five, entitled an Act "for direct-
ing the Mode of distributing the Donation Lands, promised to the Troops
by this Commonwealth; and by Order of the Surveyor General, with the
Approbation of the Honorable the Executive Council, I have surveyed on
the seventh Day of October one thousand seven hundred and eighty
five, the above described Tract of Two hundred Acres of Land, and
Allowance for Roads, &c No. 541 situate in District No. III, on the West
Side of the Alligany River, in the County of Westmoreland.
