


LOT N 581



In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly  
of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty fourth Day of February,  
one thousand seven hundred and eighty five, entitled an Act "for direct-  
ing the Mode of distributing the Donation Lands, promised to the Troops  
by this Commonwealth," and by Order of the Surveyor General, with the  
Approbation of the Honorable the Executive Council, I have surveyed  
on the tenth Day of October one thousand seven hundred and eighty five,  
the above described Tract of Two hundred Acres of Land, and Allow-  
ance for Roads, &c. No. 580 situate in District No. III, on the West Side  
of the Alligany River, in the County of Westmoreland.
