

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of
the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty-fourth Day of Feb-
ruary 1785, intitled, 'An Act for directing the Mode of distributing
The Donation-Lands promised to the Troops by this Commonwealth; and
by Order of the Surveyor-General, with the Approbation of the Honour-
able the Executive-Council, I have surveyed, on the Fifteenth Day of
November 1785, the above described Tract of Two hundred Acres of
Land, and Allowance of six per Cent for Roads, &c. No. 1192 situate
in District No. 6, on the West Side of the Allegheny River, in the
County of Westmoreland.
