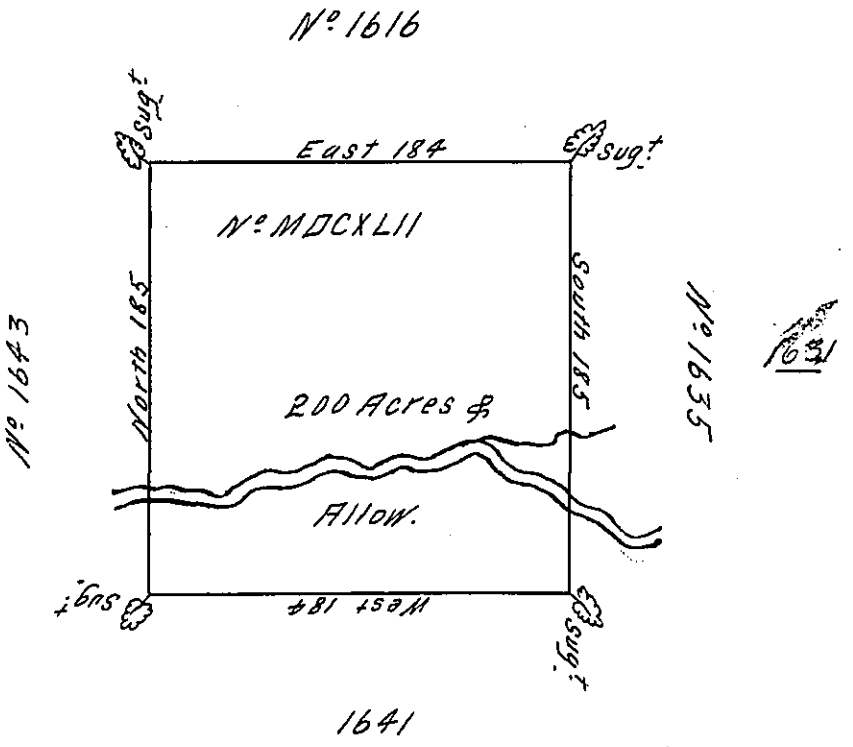


Received of James Trimble

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the
 state of Pennsylvania, passed the 24th day of February, 1785,
 entitled "An Act for directing the mode of distributing the Dona-
 tion Lands promised the Troops of this Commonwealth"; and by
 order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Honourable
 the Supreme Executive Council, I have surveyed on the 7th day of Nov-
 ember 1785, the above described Tract of two hundred acres of land
 and allowance of six per cent. for roads, &c. No. 1642 situate in
 District No. 8, on the west side of the Alleghany river, in the county
 of Westmoreland.
