


Lot N.54



In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of  
the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty fourth Day of February,  
one thousand seven hundred and eighty five, entitled an Act "for  
directing the Mode of distributing the Donation Lands, promised to the Troops  
by this Commonwealth," and by Order of the Surveyor General, with the  
Approbation of the Honorable the Executive Council, I have surveyed  
on the 24<sup>th</sup> Day of October one thousand seven hundred and eighty  
five, the above described Tract of Two hundred and fifty Acres of Land,  
and Allowance for Roads, &c. No. 55 situate in District No. III, on the  
West Side of the Alligany River, in the County of Westmoreland.
