


LOT N. 633



In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of  
the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty-fourth Day of February,  
one thousand seven hundred and eighty-five, entitled an Act "for directing  
the Mode of distributing the Donation Lands, promised to the Troops by this  
Commonwealth," and by Order of the Surveyor General, with the Appro-  
bation of the Honorable the Executive Council, I have surveyed on the  
18 Day of October one thousand seven hundred and eighty-five, the  
above described Tract of Two hundred Acres of Land, and Allowance  
for Roads, g.c. No. 632 situate in District No. III, on the West Side of  
the Alligany River, in the County of Westmoreland.
