

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of  
 the State of Pennsylvania passed the 24<sup>th</sup> Day of February 1785 entitled  
 "an Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation Lands prom-  
 ised the Troops of this Commonwealth" and by Order of the Surveyor  
 General with the Approbation of the Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Executive Council I have  
 Survey'd on the 28<sup>th</sup> Day of July 1785 the above described tract of  
 two Hundred and fifty Acres of Land & Allow<sup>ce</sup> of six Pct for Roads  
 &c. N° LXVII situate in District N° 4 on the West side of the Allegany  
 River in the County of Westmoreland.
