

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly  
of the State of Pennsylvania passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785  
entitled "an Act for directing the Mode of Distributing the Donation  
"Lands promised the Troops of this Common-wealth" and by order of  
the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Hon<sup>b</sup>le the Executive  
Council I have Surveyd on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of August 1785 the above  
described tract of two hundred Acres of Land & Allow<sup>e</sup> of six PCT  
for Roads &c. N° DCCLXI situate in District N° 4 on the west side  
of the Allegany River in the County of Westmoreland.
