



In pursuance of an Act General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania Passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785 Intituled An Act for Directing the Mode of Distributing the Donation Lands promised to the troops of this Commonwealth & by order of the Surveyor General with the Approbation of Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Execitive Council I have surveyed on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of July 1785 the above Described tract of two Hundred Acres & Allow<sup>ce</sup> of 6 P Cent for roads & MCCCXLV situate in District No 7 in the West side of the Alegeney river in the County of Westmorland.
