



In pursuance of a Warrant Bearing date December 28th 1813 was surveyed to Joshua McHenry on the 4th of May 1814 ^{above} the describ'd tract of Land containing thirty one Acres, one hundred twenty eight perches five tenths of a perch & allowance proportioned at six per Cent for Roads &c. Situate in East Huntington Township in the County of Westmoreland.

N. B. the above describ'd Tract of Land includes an improvement apparently first comm^menced in the Spring of 1803. Joshua McHenry & family was actually residing thereon at the time of surveying the same.
