



A Draught of a tract of land situate in the Township in the County of Bradford containing two hundred and ninety three acres and sixty five perches an allowance of six per cent for roads, surveyed to John Palmer the 2^d day of October 1775 by Charles - late Deputy Surveyor in pursuance of a warrant - the 27th day of October 1774 as appears by his - Draught and Notes of survey in my possession. The tract originally contained 301³/₄ acres by 8⁹⁵ & 55^P & allowance fall within the Township of Springfield one of the 17 Townships formerly of Luzerne - as appears on the face of the Draught - Examined the 15th day of February 1819 and Certified by
