



Draught of a tract of Land situate in Longswamp township Berks County, surveyed on the twenty sixth day of October A.D. 1750 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Joseph Biery, dated the fourth day of June A.D. 1750 containing one hundred and one acres, seventy two perches and the usual allowance of six $\frac{1}{2}$ Ct. for roads &c. Taken from the field works of the late James Scull former Deputy Surveyor of Berks County.
