In pursuance of An Act of Assembly passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the sale of certain lands therein mentioned, and by virtue of a Commission to me directed under the hand and Seal of Office of John Luthens Esq<sup>r</sup> surveyor General for the State of Penn<sup>a</sup> bearing date at Philadelphia the 14<sup>th</sup> of August 1783 the Above tract of land containing two hundred & twenty Nine Acres and thirty Nine Perches And allowance of 6 P. Cent for roads &c<sup>a</sup> was Surveyed on the twenty first day of June 1785 by
