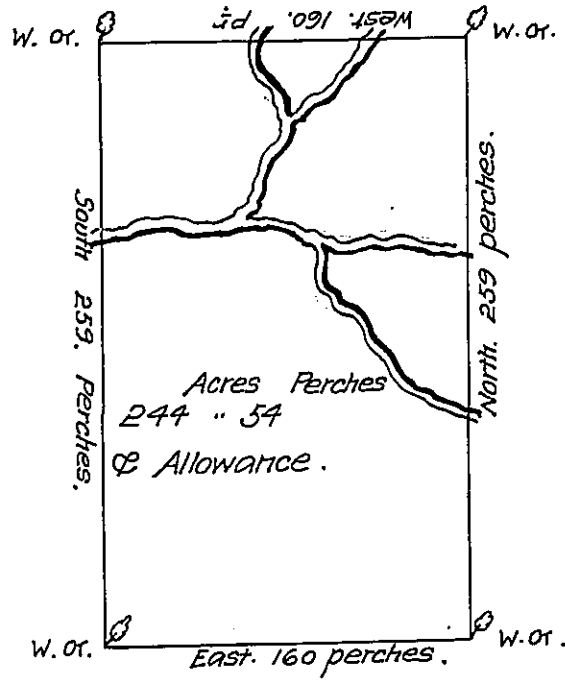

In pursuance of An Act of Assembly passed on the 12th day of March 1783 for the sale of certain lands therein Mentioned And by virtue of a Commission under the hand and seal of John Lukens Esquire Surveyor General for the state of Pennsylvania to me directed bearing date at Philad^a the 14th day of August 1783, the above tract of land containing two Hundred and forty four acres And fifty four Perches And Allowance of 6 P. Cent for roads &c^a was surveyed on the 22^d day of June 1785 by
