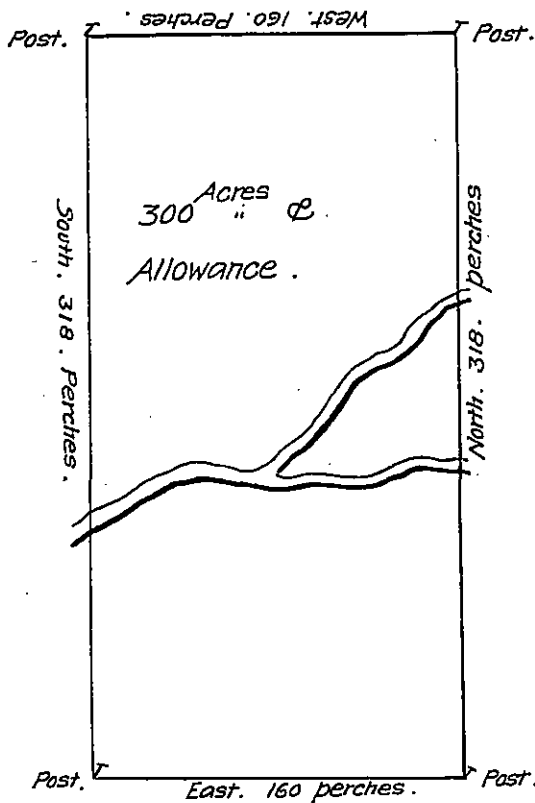

In pursuance of an Act of Assembly Passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the Sale of certain lands therein mentioned and by virtue of a Commission under the hand and Seal of Office of John Luters Esq<sup>r</sup> Surveyor General for state of Pennsylvania to me Directed bearing date at Philadelphia the 14<sup>th</sup> day of August 1783 the Above tract of land containing three hundred Acres & Allowance of Six P<sup>ct</sup> Cent for Roads &c. Was Surveyed the 4<sup>th</sup> day of July 1785 by
