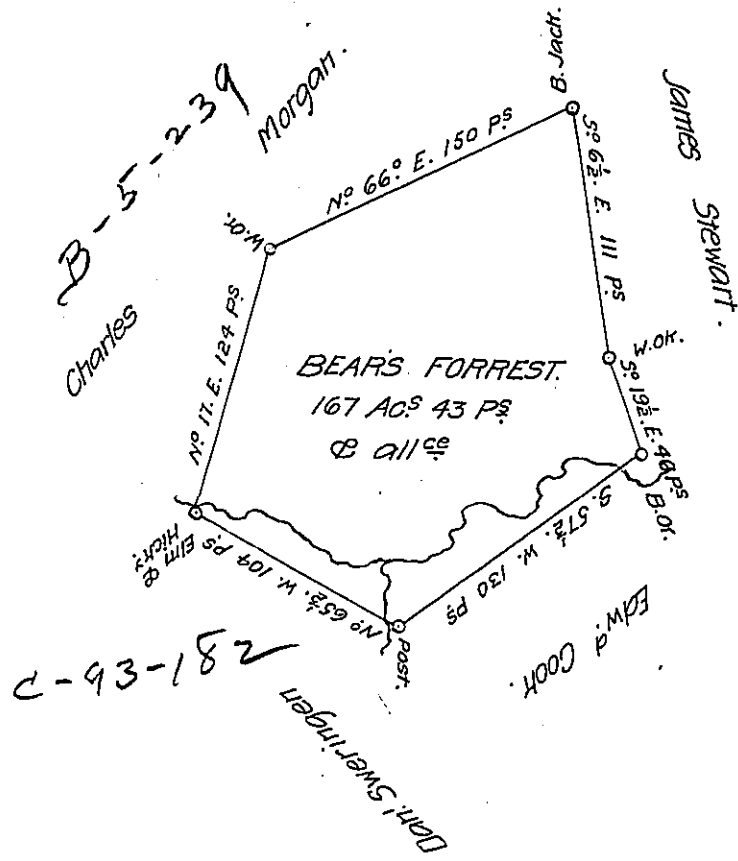

A Draught of a Survey called Bears Forrest, situate on Potatoe Garden Run a Branch of  
 Fracoon Cr. in Allegheny County, containing 167 Ac. 43 Ps. and the usual allow<sup>ce</sup> for Roads  
 &c. surveyed Apl 24<sup>th</sup> 1800 on a Warrant granted to David Cook for 400 Ac. dated August  
 the 6<sup>th</sup> 1784.

Note. this survey as originally made and returned to the Sur<sup>r</sup> Gen<sup>l</sup> included 257 Ac. 112 Ps.  
 & all<sup>ce</sup> but it interfering with other surveys, application was made to throw off the disputed  
 parts, for which purpose the Sur<sup>r</sup> Gen<sup>l</sup> issued is special order dated the 9<sup>th</sup> Jan<sup>y</sup> 1800  
 the above was made in consequence of said special order, and contains only what is  
 clear of dispute.
