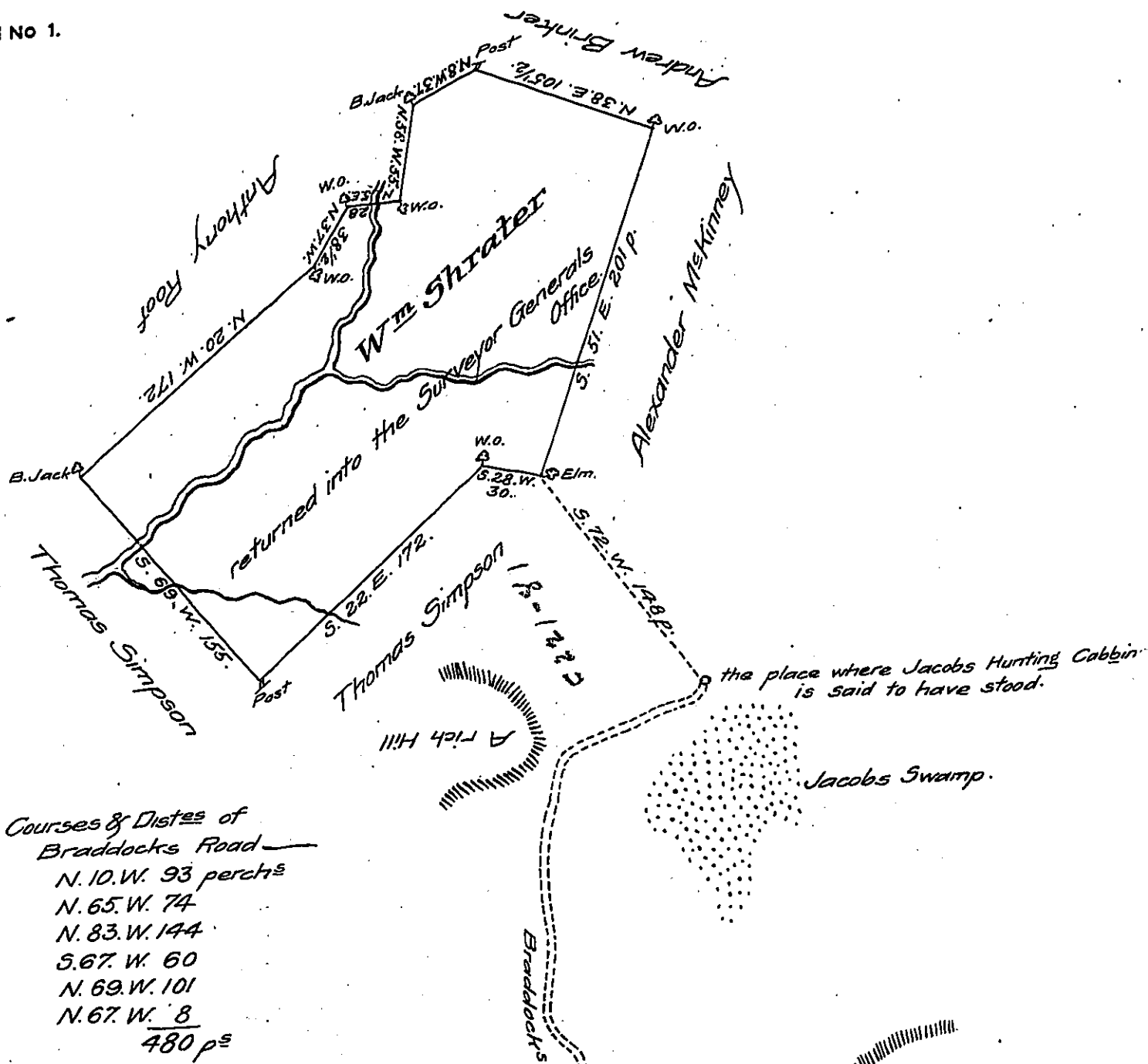

 April 3^d 1769, N^o 562 In the Name of

 from Jacobs Hunting Cabbin on Braddocks road joining a Rich Hill and lying
 between s^d Cabbin and said Creek.
