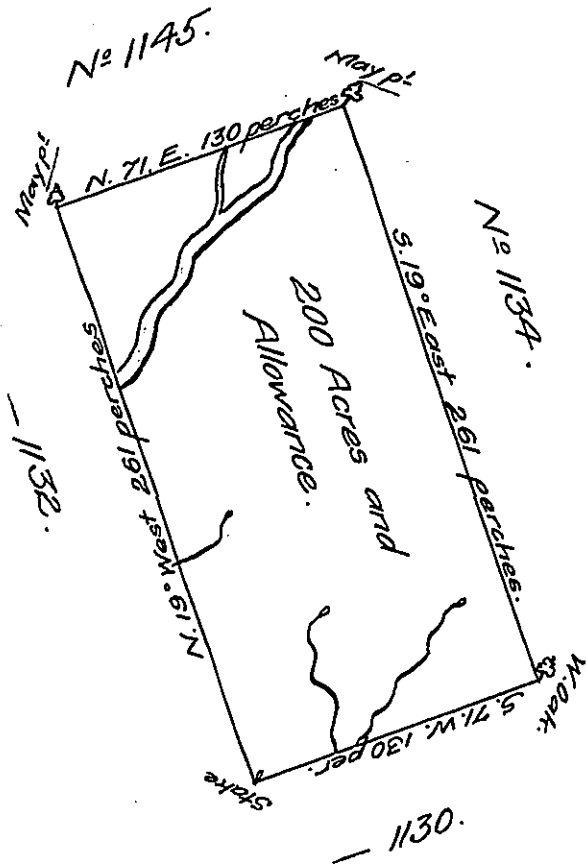


Donation Land in District No 6—
