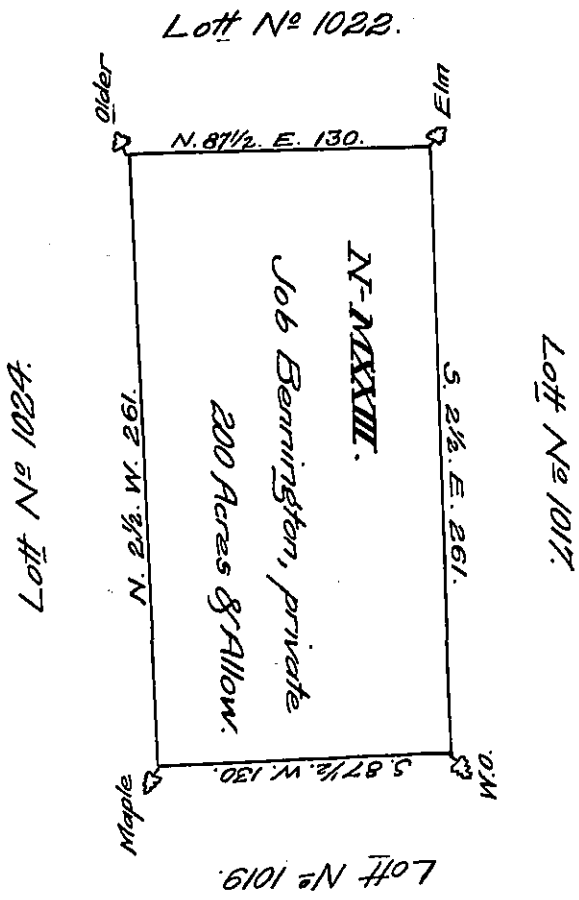

General

In Pursuance of an Act of ¹ Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania passed the 24th day of February 1785 entitled an Act for directing the mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised the Troops of this Commonwealth." & by Order of the Surveyor General with the Approbation of the Hon^{ble} the Executive Council, I have surveyed on the 27 day of October 1785 the above discribed Tract of Two Hundred Acres of Land & Allowance of Six p^{ct} Cent. for Roads &^e No. MXXIII — Situate in District No. 5 on the West side of the Alleghany River in the County of Westmoreland
