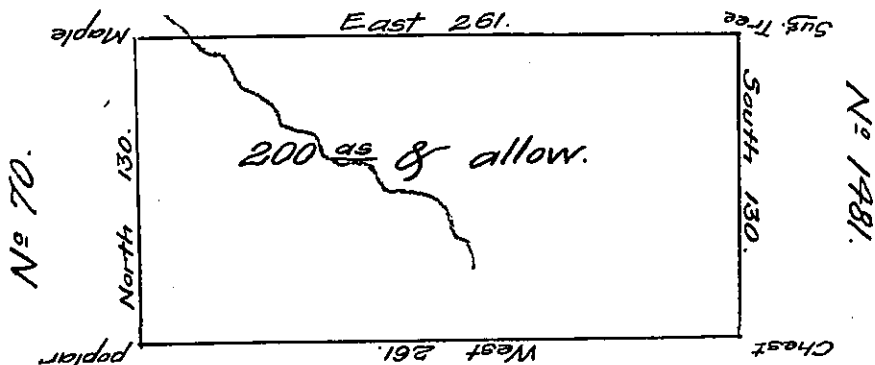

In Pursuance of an act of Genl Assembly of the state of Pennsyl-  
 vania passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day February 1785 Intitled an act for Directing the  
 mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised to the troops of this Common-  
 wealth & by order of the surveyor Genl with the approbation of the Hon. the  
 Executive Council I have surveyed on the 2<sup>d</sup> day of Sept. 1785 the above  
 described tract of two hundred Acres & Allow. of 6 ~~ff~~ Cent. for roads &c.  
 N<sup>o</sup> MDIV situate in Dist N<sup>o</sup> 7 on the West side of the Alleg<sup>y</sup> River in the  
 County of Westmorland.
