



A Draught of a tract of land in Derry township, Mifflin County containing Forty two acres and 68 perches and the allowance of six  $\frac{1}{2}$  Cent for roads &c. Surveyed ~~for~~ the 28<sup>th</sup> day of April 1803. In pursuance of a warrant granted to Samuel Martin the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December 1794.

Note The above survey of 42<sup>a</sup>. 68<sup>p</sup>. was included in a survey made by me the 10<sup>th</sup> day of October 1801 for Stephen Jordan in pursuance of an application No. 672 dated the 2<sup>d</sup> day of August 1766 and returned into the Surveyor Generals office in February 1802 with notes thereon.
