

Containing Forty two acres and 68 perches and the allowance of
six & Cent for roads &c Surveyd ~~on~~ the 28th day of April 1803. In
pursuance of a warrant granted to Samuel Martin the 31st day
of December 1794.

Note. The above survey of 42^a. 68^p.^E was included in a survey made by me the 10th day of October 1801 for Stephen Jordan in pursuance of an application No. 672 dated the 2^d day of August 1766 and returned into the Surveyor Generals office in February 1802 with notes thereon.
