


A draft of two hundred and seventy four acres and sixteen perches  
of land with six percent for roads, situate in Derry township Mifflin county  
Surveyed 16th August 1803, in pursuance of a warrant to James McDowell  
dated 18th July 1795, examined 23d June 1815. Note. The dots in the above  
draft shew old land cultivated, and said warrantee was ploughing  
part of it on the 20th instant (June 1815) and the line N 52 E cuts the  
cabin which is fallen in decay without human inhabitancy.
