



A draught of 18<sup>a</sup>. 72 perches of land with allowance of 6 per cent for roads &c. Situate in Decatur township Mifflin County Penna. Surveyed in part October 30th and finished November 9th 1855 in pursuance of a warrant to Joseph Sigler for 50<sup>a</sup>. dated June 30th 1855. No improvement on this land. The warrant calls for improved land which is a mistake.
