In pursuance of a warrant granted to John Meyers dated the 12th day of November 1804 for vacant and unimproved land and also agreeable to an act intitled an Act to Compensate David Mead and others Passed the 9th day of March 1796.

N. B. About 2 or 3 acres of the above tract is cleared Land and under cultivation said to be by John Meyers but no dwelling house appears thereon.
