



A draught of a tract of Land situate Fermanagh township Mifflin County containing seven acres and 90 perches and the allowance of six & Cent for roads &c. Survey'd the 23^d of Novr. 1804. In pursuance of a warrant granted to John Meyers dated the 12th day of November 1804 for vacant and unimproved Land and also agreeable to an Act Entitled an Act to Compensate David Mead and others. Passed the 9th day of March 1796.

N.B. The whole of the above tract appears included in a survey made for Samuel Mitchell April 9th 1767. In pursuance of a warrant dated the 12th day of August 1766.

The line bearing S 54 1/2 W 52 prs. from a post Cor. of Edward Armstrong to a B.O. Cor. of Hugh McElroy - appears to have been left an open line and not mark'd until the 26th June 1805. the lines bearing S 77 1/2 E 66 1/2 to a v.o. & N 27 W 50 to a post appear old mark'd lines said to have been formerly made for Mitchell & Armstrong.
