Draft of twenty acres and seven perches of land with six per cent for Roads Situate in Ferrinagh township in Mifflin county surveyed 15th November 1813 in pursuance of a warrant to Samuel Myers (in trust for the heirs of John Myers deceased) dated 22nd October 1813. Note, improvement at time of survey, a cabbins & family in it, and near two acres of land under good fences, obl a state of cultivation

Note also this land was ^{ret'd} in October 1813 on a warrant obl James Watts dated 14th April 1812 but, as it has since appeared, the right of the improvement is not in said Watt but in the heirs of the said John Myers, the Court has decided that the warrant of said Watt is void, not having been fairly obtained.
