



A draught of fifty acres and seventy five perches of land with the allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Situate in Decatur Township Mifflin County: Surveyed May 16th 1837, in pursuance of a warrant to Jacob Smith (Saw Miller), dated May 6th 1837. Re-surveyed and corrected Sept 29th 1857.

{ Note - The survey of 1837, included all of the Jacob Bard tract which is bounded east by Kern and Rager.
