



Situate in West Buffalo township Union (late Berks) county surveyed the 6<sup>th</sup> day of August 1832 by virtue of an ~~the~~ order granted to Benjamin Allison dated the 6<sup>th</sup> day of October 1766 No. 1425 containing two hundred & forty one acres with the usual allowance of six pr. Ct. &c.

Note The same tract of land was surveyed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of May 1769 for Edward Lee in pursuance of his Warrant dated the 7<sup>th</sup> day of February 1755 and now owned & occupied by Samuel Barber in right of the said Edward Lee.
