


FORM NO. 1.



Draught of a tract of land situate in Letterkenny township Franklin County, containing one hundred and thirty three acres sixty seven perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Located by virtue of an order of survey granted to Joseph Gulbertson for 100 A. of land "joining Jeremiah Sebwin (alias Gelvins) Land John Gulbertson and William Sharp" bearing date 21 October 1766 No. 1621, and in pursuance of ~~the order of Survey~~ a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several acts of assembly relating to unpatented Lands under proprietary rights &c.

Report. The above tract of land is wholly covered by a survey of 133 a. 48 ps. made the 18 April 1806 on a warrant to William Rail bearing date the 19 May 1794 & confirmed by Patent 16 May 1806 to said Rail. Note. The above land recognized as the land of Joseph Gulbertson in the year 1765 by adjoining surveys. Isaac Brewbaker owner & occupier of part. Elizabeth Fry part. David Hostetter tenant under her — Mary Hostetter owner & occupier of part. W. Rail Pat'd. W. S. D.
