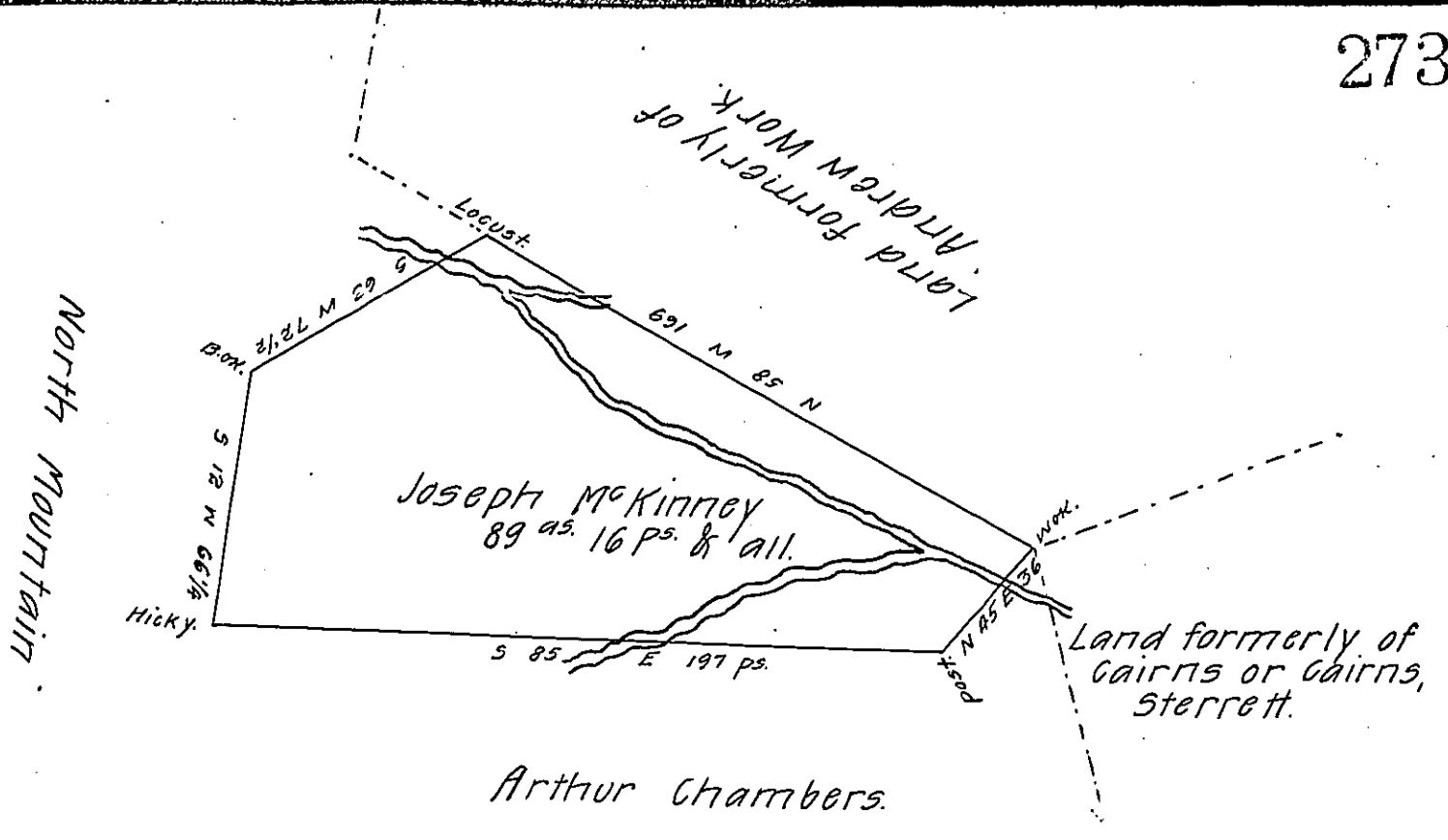


FORM NO 1.



Draft of a tract of land situate in Montgomery township Franklin County containing eighty nine acres sixteen perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c. surveyed the 10th of December 1828. In pursuance of a contract with the Board of property for carrying in to effect the several acts of assembly relating to proprietary rights & an application granted Joseph McKinney Jr. for 150 as of land joining Cairns or Cairns Sterritt on the N.W. side running from his north corner tree to his S.W. corner tree betwixt said Sterritts & the north mountain upon a small stream of water dated the 11th of October 1766. No. 1516.

The land above described is the the same as a survey of 89^{as.} 16 ps & all which was surveyed an application granted Cairns Sterritt dated the 8th of February 1768 No. 4741 under which the present owners claim there is no evidence of any survey having been made on McKinneys application.
