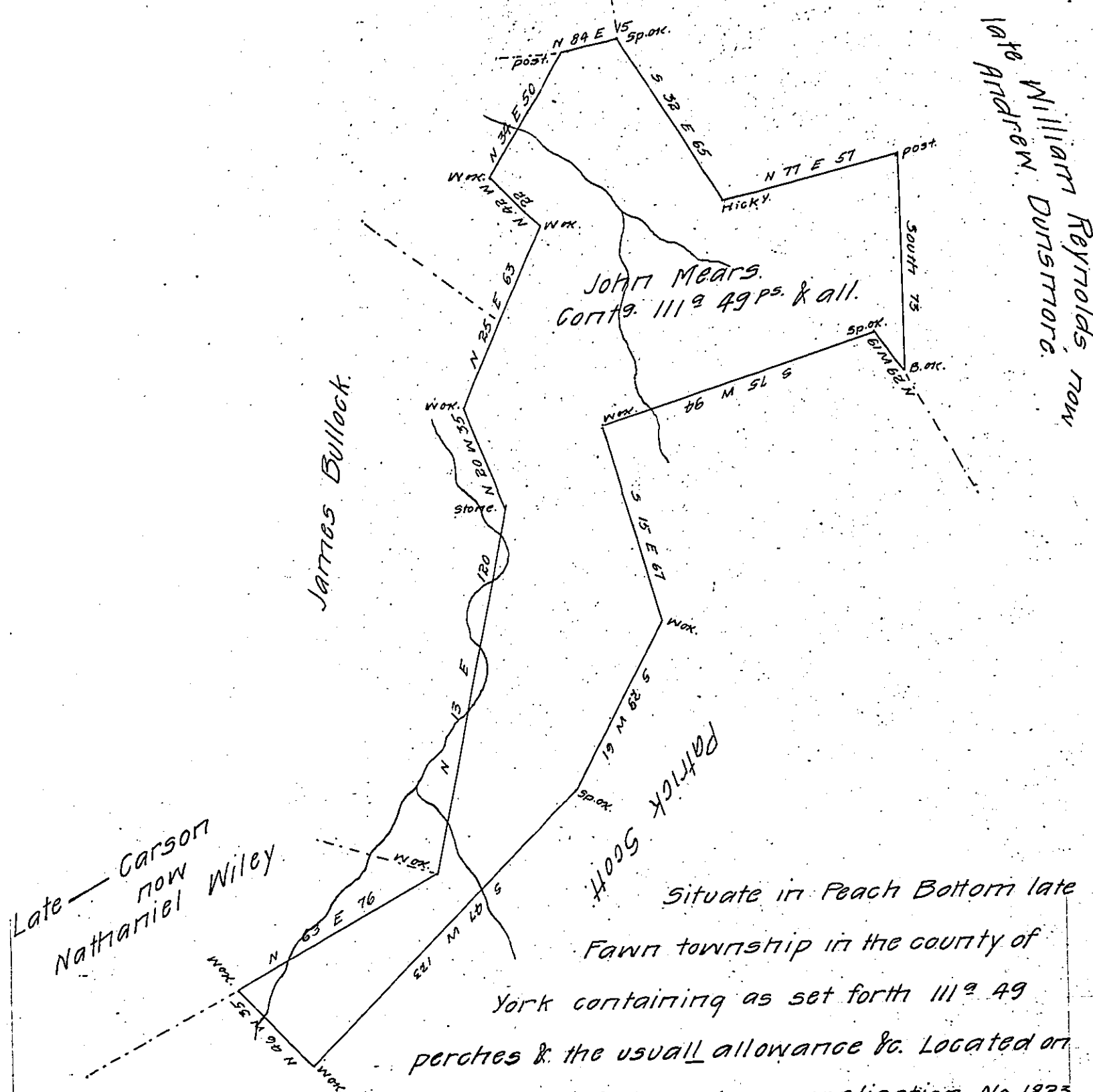


FORM NO 1.



Situate in Peach Bottom late Fawn township in the county of York containing as set forth 111 9 49 perches & the usual allowance &c. Located on the 16th day of June 1831 in pursuance of John Mears application No 1823 for 200 ac. dated the 6 of November 1766 & by virtue of the contract entered into with the Board of Property.

Report The above is wholly covered and is the same land which W^m Kersey surveyed and returned in pursuance of a warrant granted to Ephraim M^cCourtney dated the 30 day of January 1789. Under which right it is now held and in possession of Ephraim M^cCourtney John Mears has never been heard of by any of the neighbours now living To the Board of Property
