


FORM No 1.



A Draft of a tract of land situate on the east side of Mills Creek, & near the Maryland line in Londonberry township Bedford County containing sixty one & one half acres and the usual allowance of 6 per cent. Surveyed on order No. 1773 dated the 1st day of November 1766 granted to John Henthorn. A survey represented by the Lake colored lines, in the name of Benjamin Tomlinson, surveyed upon a warrant granted to him dated the 13th day of May 1790. Interfers sixty one & one half acres.

John Henthorn sold this land to Joseph Tomlinson, who sold to Benjamin Tomlinson (the present owner & occupier) who obtained the aforesaid warrant.
