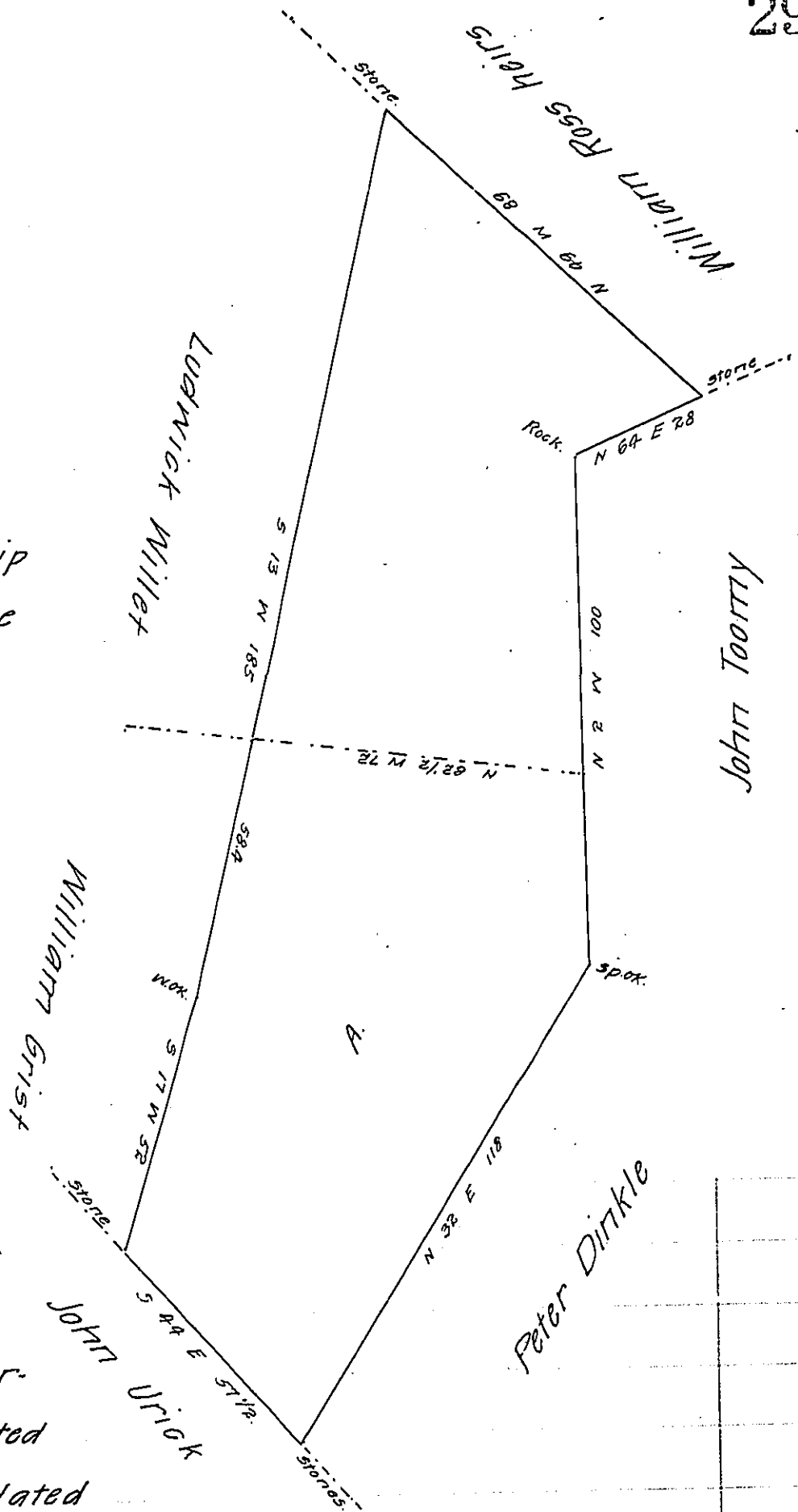


FORM NO 1.

Situate in Warrington township in the county of York, The whole tract containing within the black lines 91^{as}. 69 perches &c. Was originally surveyed by Charles Lukens late D.S. in pursuance of William Wickersham's Application for 90^{as}. No. 1780 dated the 3^d day of November 1766, and the part wherein the letter A is placed containing about — as embraced in a survey of 104^{as}. 139^{ps} &c. made in pursuance of a warrant granted to Joshua Davis for 90^{as} dated the 5th day of October 1772 and patented to the said Davis the 31st day of March 1774, This part is owned and occupied by William Grist, and the other part by Ludwig Willet, and Alexander Ross's heirs. Reported &c. 12th November 1828. per contract.
